



Daifuku Dining Chair Brown Set Of Two

Big roundovers borrow their softness from mochi—the chair's namesake. Daifuku turns hard ash into something that reads soft and rounded, a low-back dining chair that feels relaxed the moment you sit down. Solid white ash takes a warm walnut stain, with an ash-veneer seat over plywood for a smooth, steady surface. Kiln-dried wood keeps its shape through seasonal swings, and protective leg glides keep floors in the clear. Good luck, in chair form.

- **Soft Roundovers:** Generous rounded edges give the low-back silhouette an unexpectedly soft, approachable feel, a nod to the mochi that inspired the Daifuku name.
- **Solid Ash Frame:** A solid white ash frame in a warm walnut stain meets an ash-veneer seat that resists stains, water, and scratches through everyday meals.
- **Kiln-Dried For Stability:** Kiln-dried wood resists warping and cracking through seasonal humidity swings, so the chair holds its shape and finish over years of use.
- **Floor-Friendly Glides:** Protective leg glides come included, letting the chairs slide out and back without scuffing or scratching the floor beneath them.
- **NHLA-Certified Ash:** The ash is certified by the National Hardwood Lumber Association, supporting responsible North American hardwood sourcing and sound, sustainable forest management.
