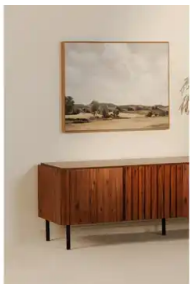

# Lincoln Media Cabinet Brown

Overlapping wood panels, borrowed from the hull of a sailboat. Clinker boatbuilding lays planks over one another, and the Lincoln media cabinet brings that detail to the front of a mid-century modern piece. Solid acacia doors and sides carry a matt brown finish, with acacia veneer over MDF and a finished back so it works anywhere in the room. Four doors close softly, and iron legs lift the whole cabinet off the floor. Old boatbuilding detail, everyday media storage.

- Planks on Purpose: Overlapping wooden panels across the front borrow from clinker boatbuilding, giving a mid-century modern cabinet a textured front you notice right away.
- Grain You Can See: Solid acacia doors and sides carry a matt brown finish that keeps the wood grain visible across the front and along both sides.
- Finished All Around: A fully finished back and raised iron legs let the cabinet work mid-room as comfortably as it does against a wall.
- Four Doors, Soft Close: Four doors run on soft close glides, so each one shuts gently and keeps media gear stored out of sight inside.
